Anan's habitable artworks are unique concepts. Each of his creations contemplates ecology and sustainability as a conscious lifestyle.

All this is conceived within the possibilities of the client and considering the constructive permits of the region under concern, given that many times the government does not allow to build with noble materials, such as mud.

With each work we aim to erase the carbon footprint that is generated by construction by with tree planting, achieving projects with neutral carbon footprint, as in the last two projects: "Equilibrium Healing Resort" where work was done jointly together with Claire Boudreault in Puerto Vallarta, Mexico; and "Granja Kaypacha" (Kaypacha Farm), located in Tapalpa Jalisco, Mexico.

In many cases, Anan usually accompanies his projects with organic orchards, land with rainwater management for infiltration of moisture without loss of soil, and the use of technology, trying to use it to the maximum to make more efficient spaces in an ecological and energetic sense.

He has developed projects in Uruguay,

Bolivia, Chile, Colombia and Mexico.
